Grace Bay Club, an all-suite luxury resort on the idyllic Turks and Caicos island of Providenciales, tapped well-known interior designer Thom Filicia to update its look with a contemporary twist on traditional island style. The latest piece of the redesign—which began last year with the lobby—is the 38 suites in the Villas, a family-friendly collection of four five-story buildings with its own pool and restaurant. Filicia is also wrapping up a refresh of the main restaurant, now called Infiniti. Situated on tranquil Grace Bay, the 11-acre resort has 1,100 feet of beach access. The main building, next up on the renovation docket, has additional eateries, a pool, and a spa.

“I wanted the Villas to offer a comfortable, fresh, and fun approach to island living,” says Filicia. “With their bold patterns, bright Bahamian colors, and a mix of materials and textures—all of which feel serene and relaxed—these homes away from home have an easy, engaging spirit.”
